Plain black or white (non-branded) trainers for outdoor P.E.

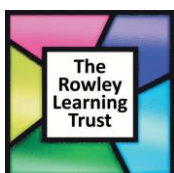
Again, it has been seen that children are using PE days as an opportunity to wear their own clothes, which is unacceptable.

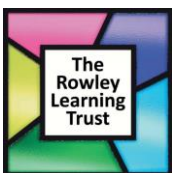
