Dear Pupils and Parents,

As you are aware, your child's production of *'Cinderella'* is fast approaching, with it now only being a few weeks away. Below is some key information regarding the show dates and costumes.

On Tuesday 7th July, your child will come to school as normal. However they will not go home at the usual time of 3:15pm. Instead they will stay in school for the performance which starts at 4:00pm. The show is approximately 1 and a half hours long. So you will need to then collect your child at 5:45pm if you do not have tickets for this performance. We recommend that your child brings an extra snack or small lunch on this day to keep them going throughout the afternoon.

On Wednesday 8th July, your child will come to school as normal and go home at the normal time of 3:15pm. Your child will then either need to come back to school for 5pm if they are a girl or 5:30pm if they are a boy ready for the show to start at 6pm. This time allows us to sort hair, make-up, costumes etc for the performance. We advise that your child eats a decent meal while at home, so there is no need to bring food back to school. Your child will then need to be collected by an adult from school at 7:45pm once the show finishes, if you do not have tickets for this performance. If for some reason you cannot collect and return your child for the time stated please contact a member of the year 6 team.

Refreshments and a raffle will be on offer for each performance. All proceeds go towards the cost of the costumes provided by school. Can I take this opportunity to remind you that no photos, recordings or live video are permitted during the performance. We will photograph the children in their costumes and send you a copy via email.

Children will not be allowed to walk home on their own after this performance and can you also please ensure they do not bring their mobile phones.

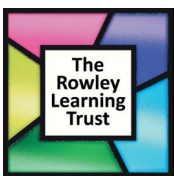
