This week, we have been enjoying the stories Spot Goes to Nursery and Where's Spot? We have been talking about the stories and discussing what is happening, using the pictures to help us understand and share our ideas. We have been focusing on settling into nursery, building confidence and developing good listening skills. We have also been talking about the characters' feelings and linking these to our own experiences of starting nursery, such as feeling happy, excited, nervous or worried. The children have enjoyed joining in with the stories and sharing their own thoughts and experiences.

Marvellous Maths

This week, we have been developing our early maths skills through lots of fun and engaging activities. We have been singing number songs and rhymes such as "1, 2, 3, 4, 5, Once I Caught a Fish Alive" and "Five Currant Buns", as well as practising counting forwards to 10. These songs and rhymes help us to develop our counting skills and become familiar with numbers in a fun and meaningful way. We will continue to explore numbers through songs, games and everyday activities in nursery.
